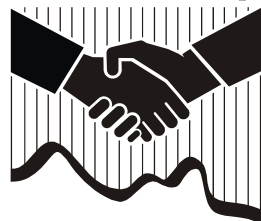

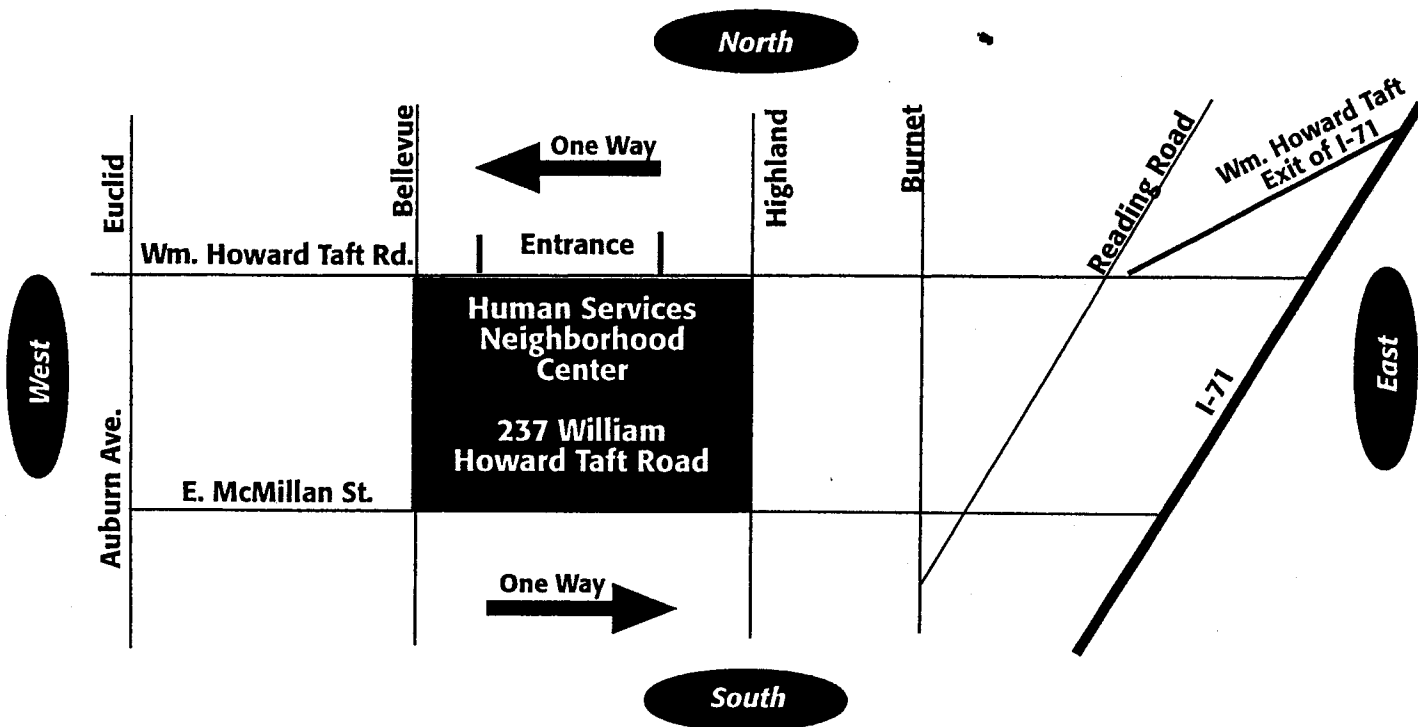
Countywide Town Meeting Comments Incorporated into Vision

If you are traveling south:

- Take I-71 south to the William Howard Taft Exit
- Exit ramp merges into William Howard Taft Road
- Take William Howard Taft to Auburn Ave. turn left
- Take Auburn Ave. to E. McMillan turn left
- Turn into the entrance marked DHS Employee Parking
- Park in any available space.
- Use back entrance

If you are traveling north:

- Take Reading Road north
- At the stop light turn left on Burnet Ave.
- Turn left on William Howard Taft.
- Turn left on Auburn Ave.
- Turn left on E. McMillan
- Turn into the entrance marked DHS Employee Parking
- Park in any available space
- Use back entrance
